**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 99-16**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 4.30.010 IN ACCORDANCE WITH
ACTION TAKEN UNDER ORDINANCE 99-06 WHICH REPEALED
TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL BOARD**

WHEREAS, on March 2, 1999, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly enacted Ordinance 99-06 which repealed term limits for members of the School Board; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 99-06 failed to remove the term limit language from the Borough Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, this failure has resulted in conflicting provisions within the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this ordinance to remove the conflicting provisions in KPB 4.30.010 in order to assure consistency within the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That KPB 4.30.010(C) is amended to read as follows:

C. A candidate for school board must be a qualified voter of the State of Alaska and a resident of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for 180 days immediately preceding filing for office. [A PERSON WHO HAS SERVED ON THE SCHOOL BOARD FOR TWO CONSECUTIVE FULL TERMS MAY NOT BE REELECTED TO THAT OFFICE UNTIL 180 DAYS HAS INTERVENED.]


SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
