## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 99-22

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999-2000

WHEREAS, the Assembly is required by Alaska Statute 14.14.060(c) to make an appropriation for the local share of funding for the school budget by June 30; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 99approxed a total school budget of $\$ 85,647,900$ and established that up to $\$ 29,435,314$ ( $\$ 23, \$ 13,189$ local effort and $\$ 5,922,125$ in-kind services) be provided from local sourcesfor school purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That subject to the provisions of this ordinance, the following is appropriated to the school fund from local sources for schodl operations purposes and in-kind services for the year July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2000:
A. Local Effort
B. Borough Maintenance
\$23,513,189
C. School District Utilities 5,075,495
D. Insurance 44,607 704,577
E. Audit 26,000
F. Custodial Services

Local Contribution per AS 14.17.025
SECTION 2. Disbursements from the direct appropriation in Section 1, item (A), shall be made monthly, and only as needed to supplement other revenues availableand received by the school district to fund the operations portion of the school district budget. Any available balance remaining at the end of the fiscal year shall then be disbursed to the school district, provided that the total amount disbursed shall not exceed the amount allowed under AS 14.17.410 as determined after actual enrollment numbers are
