**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 99-24**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 IN SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM
THE ROAD SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE TO THE ROAD SERVICE AREA
OPERATING BUDGET FOR UNPLANNED ROAD MAINTENANCE COSTS
ASSOCIATED WITH GREATER THAN NORMAL SNOWFALL**

WHEREAS, snowfall during the winter of 1998-1999 has been greater than normal throughout the borough, and extraordinarily heavy in the Homer and Seward areas; and

WHEREAS, snow removal is essential to maintaining safe access for the citizens of the borough; and

WHEREAS, heavy snowfall this fiscal year has resulted in expenditures beyond the amount budgeted for snow removal in the FY99 budget; and

WHEREAS, services such as summer grading, dust control and minor road repairs may be subject to significant reductions in the absence of a supplemental funding appropriation; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the road service area fund balance to support this appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Road Service Area Board has authorized the Roads Director to request this supplemental appropriation; and

WHEREAS, hearing on a shortened basis is requested in order to provide the funds necessary for essential road maintenance through the end of the current fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$100,000 is appropriated from the unappropriated Road Service Area Fund Balance to the FY99 Road Maintenance budget, account 236.33950.46910, to provide supplemental funding for essential road maintenance services.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
