**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 99-39**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN SERVICES
TO RECONFIGURE NIKISKI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO A MIDDLE SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, members of the Nikiski community have proposed that Nikiski schools would be improved by converting the Nikiski Elementary School to a middle school, housing students in the sixth, seventh, and eighth grades, and transferring existing elementary students to North Star Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board, at its June 7, 1999, meeting approved action to continue the process of reconfiguring Nikiski area schools; and

WHEREAS, the borough has received a request from the school board for a \$40,000 appropriation for schematic design services to assess necessary code upgrades and classroom space reconfiguration for this project; and


WHEREAS, the assembly finds that the borough's and school district's best interests would be served by obtaining such services;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$40,000 shall be appropriated from the general fund to account 100.31110.99NIK.43011 in the Public Works Department for schematic design services reconfiguring Nikiski Elementary School to a middle school.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
