## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 99-52

## AN ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING STATE GRANTS TO NINILCHIK AND MOOSE PASS FOR COMMUNITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

- WHEREAS, in 1993 the Kenai Peninsula Borough was awarded two grants under Grants to Municipalities (AS 37.05.315); one for Ninilchik Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety Improvements (\$200,000) and one for the Moose Pass Safety Path Extension (\$15,000); and
- WHEREAS, the Borough entered into a Transfer of Responsibility Agreement ("TORA") with the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for completion of the grant projects; and
- WHEREAS, due to design problems and lack of consensus within the communities, neither of these projects have been completed; and
- WHEREAS, during this past session, the Alaska State Legislature authorized reappropriations to amend the purposes of the grants;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement, thereby accepting the provisions therein, and to accept a grant for Ninilchik Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety Improvements and Purchase of a Safety Vehicle in the amount of \$200,000 as reappropriated by the Alaska Legislature (Chapter 2, FSSLA 1999).
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$200,000 are hereby appropriated to account No. 420.51710.51109.49999.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement, thereby accepting the provisions therein, and to accept a grant for Moose Pass Safety Path Extension and Community Improvements in the amount of \$15,000 as reappropriated by the Alaska Legislature (Chapter 2, FSSLA 1999).

SECTION 4. That grant funds in the amount of \$15,000 are hereby appropriated to account No. 271.91240.51106.49999.

**SECTION 5**. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
