AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$41,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE FOR THE OCTOBER 26, 1999 RUNOFF ELECTION

WHEREAS, in the October 5, 1999 Regular Election no candidate for the office of borough mayor received the required majority vote; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KPB 4.10.070(A) a runoff election must be held two weeks after the certification of the regular election; and

WHEREAS, there are insufficient funds in the elections budget to cover the cost of a runoff election; and

WHEREAS, there is no assembly meeting occurring prior to the runoff election date of October 26, 1999, making it necessary to request an emergency appropriation of funds to cover the cost of the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the assembly appropriates \$41,000 from the General Fund Balance as follows:

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
