## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-03

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 5.35, KPB 14.31, AND KPB 14.32 TO INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF PROPERTIES ALLOWED TO BE DELINQUENT IN ORDER TO FORM A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the delinquent properties in a special assessment district cannot exceed 4 percent of the estimated costs of improvement; and

WHEREAS, the delinquency formula is preventing otherwise feasible improvements projects; and

WHEREAS, 10 percent would be a reasonable delinquency rate which would both protect the borough's interest in assessment districts and promote feasible projects; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That KPB 5.35.070(D) is hereby amended as follows:
  - D. In no case shall a special assessment district be approved where properties which will bear more than [FOUR (4%)] ten (10) percent of the estimated costs of the improvement are delinquent in payment of borough property taxes from the immediately preceding tax year.
- **SECTION 2.** That KPB 14.31.080(A)(2) is hereby amended as follows:
  - 2. A special assessment district may not be formed if parcels in the proposed district which would bear more than [FOUR (4%)] ten (10) percent of the estimated cost of the improvement are delinquent in payment of borough real property taxes in the immediately preceding tax year.
- **SECTION 3.** That KPB 14.32.080(A)(2) is hereby amended as follows:
  - 2. A special assessment district may not be formed if parcels in the proposed district which would bear more than [FOUR (4%)] ten (10) percent of the estimated cost of the improvement are delinquent in payment of borough real property taxes in the immediately preceding tax year.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
