KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-19-16

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A \$44,032 GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA WELLNESS AND FITNESS PROGRAMS

- WHEREAS, the U.S. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has created the Assistance to Firefighters Grant program to help rural fire departments with funding for equipment, personal protective gear, and wellness/fitness programs; and
- WHEREAS, Bear Creek Fire Service Area applied for funding medical physicals and physical fitness equipment and has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$44,032; and
- WHEREAS, the grant program requires that (1) grantees share in the cost of the project, (2) grantees serving jurisdictions of 50,000 or fewer residents provide a non-Federal cost share of 10% of the total project cost, and (3) the cost share must be in cash; and
- WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$4,893 are currently available in account 207.51210.43014 (physical examinations) for this purpose in the approved Service Area operating budget; and
- WHEREAS, the local share contribution of \$4,893 and the FEMA grant amount of \$44,032 will provide a total of \$48,925 to be used for medical examinations and physical fitness equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents necessary to accept a grant in the amount of \$44,032 from FEMA for wellness programs and physical fitness equipment.
- SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$44,032 are hereby appropriated to Bear Creek Fire Service Area as follows:
 \$34,432 to account number 207.51210.02FG2.43014 (physical examinations)
 \$9,600 to account number 207.51210.02FG2.48513 (recreational equipment)
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
