**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2001-19-17**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE  
ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL  
RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING \$3,100 TO THE  
BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA**

**WHEREAS,** the Bear Creek Fire Service Area applied for a grant under the 2001 Volunteer Fire Assistance program administered by the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry; and

**WHEREAS,** notice has been received that a grant has been awarded to the Bear Creek Fire Service Area in the amount of \$3,100; and

**WHEREAS,** the Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant program requires a one-to-one match of local expenditures to the grant funds; and

**WHEREAS,** matching funds in the amount of \$3,100 are available in the Service Area budget under account number 207.51210.48514; and

**WHEREAS,** on August 14, 2001, the Service Area Board approved acceptance of the Volunteer Fire Assistance grant and expenditure of the grant and matching funds to purchase fire response equipment;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to accept the Volunteer Fire Assistance grant funds from the Department of Natural Resources on behalf of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area and is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.


