## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002

- WHEREAS, on June 5, 2001, the assembly enacted Ordinance 2001-19 appropriating \$50,000 in funds for fiscal year FY2001-2002 for Kachemak Emergency Service Area and requested that the service area proposed additions to their budget as their operating plans became known; and
- WHEREAS, on August 7, 2001, the assembly enacted Ordinance 2001-19-07 appropriating an additional \$139,287 providing the Kachemak Emergency Service Area with a total of \$189,287 in funding for the first half of fiscal year 2001-2002; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary that additional funding be provided for the second half of the fiscal year 2001-2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area Board approved a budget at their board meeting held November 15, 2001 to submit to the assembly that provides funding for the second half of fiscal year 2001-2002; and
- **WHEREAS,** hearing on shortened hearing is necessary to provide the necessary funding prior to the start of the second half of fiscal year 2001-2002.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

**SECTION 1.** That Kachemak Emergency Service Area appropriation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002 is revised to \$382,279, a net increase of \$192,992, by revising the current approved budget as follows:
