- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough established the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) to meet requirements of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act (EPCRA); and
- WHEREAS, the LEPC membership consists of private individuals, public entities, and industry representatives who serve as a public education and information source for disaster preparedness throughout the borough; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Military & Veterans Affairs, Division of Emergency Services, has provided a \$26,000 grant to the Kenai Peninsula Borough LEPC through the Office of Emergency Management to fund one-third of the secretarial position necessary to provide administrative support to the LEPC and for preparation of specific work products or activities in FY 2002;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept the grant of \$26,000 from the Alaska Department of Military & Veterans Affairs, Division of Emergency Services.
- **SECTION 2.** That the grant funds are appropriated to Account No. 852.91120.LEP02.49999.
- **SECTION 3.** That the mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept the grant.
- **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
