KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-19-28

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING \$5,000 TO THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Volunteer Fire Department applied for a grant under the 2001 Volunteer Fire Assistance program administered by the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received that a grant has been awarded to the Anchor Point Volunteer Fire Department in the amount of \$5,000; and
- WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Volunteer Fire Department intends to pass the grant funds to the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant program requires a one-to-one match of local expenditures to the grant funds; and
- **WHEREAS,** matching funds in the amount of \$5,000 were expended in fiscal year 2001 and are eligible to meet the match requirements of the grant; and
- WHEREAS, on December 18, 2001, the Service Area Board recommended acceptance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to accept the Volunteer Fire Assistance grant funds from the Department of Natural Resources through the Anchor Point Volunteer Fire Department on behalf of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area and is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.
- SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$5,000 are appropriated to the following Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Fire Service operating fund account 209.51410.22VFA.49999 for the purchase of firefighting and rescue equipment.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment
