AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$229,425 FROM THE LAND TRUST FUND BALANCE FOR EXCAVATION AND REMEDIATION OF HYDROCARBON-IMPACTED SOILS AND PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT AT THE NANWALEK ELEMENTARY/HIGH SCHOOL

- WHEREAS, the Borough Maintenance Department found hydrocarbon-impacted soils at the Nanwalek School during routine maintenance work in the summer of 2000; and
- WHEREAS, 450 cubic yards of diesel-contaminated soil were excavated in the summer of 2000 and are currently stored on-site; and
- WHEREAS, as part of the excavation, a playground structure had to be removed and demolished; and
- WHEREAS, another 150 cubic yards of contaminated material still remain to be excavated; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough is required to remediate these soils to levels acceptable by the Department of Environmental Conservation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That \$229,425.00 is appropriated from the Land Trust Fund Balance to account 250.21210.02NAN.49999 for excavation and remediation of hydrocarbon-impacted soils and replacement of playground equipment at the Nanwalek Elementary/High School.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
