## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-19-38

## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CLASS A FIRE PUMPER BY THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 2001-19-14 previously appropriated \$177,285 for the purchase of a Class A Fire Pumper; and
- **WHEREAS,** on January 21, 2002, bid packets were sent to seventeen vendors and advertised in the Peninsula Clarion and the Anchorage Daily News; and
- **WHEREAS,** the low responsive bid was received from United Fire Service in the amount of \$233,690; and
- WHEREAS, the United Fire Services bid was subsequently negotiated down to a price of \$219,550 per authority granted under KPB 5.28.230 (C); and
- WHEREAS, additional funds of \$42,265 are needed to complete the purchase of the pumper; and
- WHEREAS, the Kachemak Service Area Board has identified \$23,000 in its capital project fund and \$19,265 in its operating fund that can be redirected to provide the necessary funding; and
- **WHEREAS,** shortened hearing is requested in order to minimize disruption to the project schedule:

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That supplemental funds in the amount of \$42,265 are hereby appropriated to Kachemak Emergency Service Area capital improvement fund account number 446.51810.16959.48514 for the purchase of a Class A Fire Pumper.
- **SECTION 2.** That the mayor is authorized to award a contract to United Fire Service in the amount of \$219,550 for the purchase of a Class A Fire Pumper.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
