**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2001-19-41**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EMERGENCY FUNDING FOR DESIGN AND
REPLACEMENT OF THE SEPTIC SYSTEM AT THE NORTH PENINSULA
RECREATION SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the septic system at North Peninsula Recreation pool facility has failed and is in need of immediate replacement; and

WHEREAS, the failure of the septic system has created a health risk; and

WHEREAS, design and replacement of the septic system is estimated to cost approximately \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the service area has sufficient funding in its capital project fund balance to support the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.25.030 and KPB 5.04.080 allow the assembly to make emergency appropriations to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, welfare or property, by ordinance, without notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AS 29.25.030 the emergency ordinance remains in effect for sixty days; and

WHEREAS, the assembly finds an emergency exists based upon the above facts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$30,000 is appropriated from the North Peninsula Recreation Capital Improvement fund balance to account number 459.61110.02SEP.43011 for design, permitting, and construction cost associated with a new septic system.


SECTION 2. That the mayor is authorized to waive formal bidding procedures and to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in a timely manner.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
