KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-25

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2001 KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPORTIONMENT PLANS AND PLACING THE APPORTIONMENT PLANS ON THE BALLOT FOR BOROUGH VOTER SELECTION

- WHEREAS, in Resolution 2001-040 the borough assembly determined that it is currently malapportioned based upon the 2000 population figures from the U. S. Census Bureau; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to that resolution, the assembly president appointed a reapportionment committee to consider and propose plans to correct the malapportionment; and
- WHEREAS, the committee has referred four alternative assembly representation plans for assembly selection including single member districts of either seven, nine, eleven, or thirteen districts; and
- WHEREAS, the committee recommends that the assembly submit two plans to the voters; and
- WHEREAS, AS 29.20.070(c) requires the assembly to submit to the voters proposed forms of representation, and AS 29.20.080(e) requires that the assembly by ordinance adopt an ordinance providing for reapportionment and submit it to the voters within six months of the determination of malapportionment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly adopts two borough assembly representation plans to be selected by borough voters: Plan 1 includes 9 single member districts, and Plan 2 includes 13 single member districts, both of which are described in the 2001 Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly Reapportionment Plan, attached to and incorporated by reference into this ordinance as Attachment 1. In both plans, assembly members would be elected by voters residing in the district the assembly member represents.
- **SECTION 2.** That the following proposition be placed on the ballot of the October 2, 2001 regular borough election:

PROPOSITION: CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING PLANS FOR KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATION:

Plan 1: 9 single member districts

Plan 2: 13 single member districts

DESCRIPTION OF APPORTIONMENT PLAN: State law requires that the Kenai Peninsula Borough assembly adopt an apportionment plan for borough assembly representation, after the 2000 federal census.

Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 2001-25 meets this requirement by adopting and presenting to the voters for selection two representation and apportionment options, both of which are different from the current plan. The plan receiving the most votes will be put into place after the election. Either plan will result in some or all of the current assembly terms and seats being abolished beginning with the regular borough election in October 2002. Assembly members elected in 2002 will serve staggered terms of one, two and three years. The current assembly apportionment plan contains 9 districts with one member elected from each district.

The first option, Plan 1, would consist of 9 districts in the borough. Each district would have one assembly member, elected by the voters of that district.

The second option, Plan 2, would consist of 13 districts in the borough. Each district would have one assembly member, elected by the voters of that district.

SECTION 3. That the assembly shall, after certification of the October 2, 2001 election, adopt or enact such ordinances or other actions that are necessary to provide for the composition of the assembly in accordance with the plan of representation and apportionment that receives the most votes.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
