KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE TO THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES PORTIONS OF THREE PARCELS OF BOROUGH LAND TO PROVIDE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE HOMER EAST ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- **WHEREAS,** the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) has proposed and received funding to improve the Homer East Road a major rural connector; and
- WHEREAS, the borough supports the Homer East Road Improvement Project; and
- WHEREAS, DOT/PF has identified three parcels of borough land on which it needs to acquire strips of land for construction and expansion of the roadway; and
- **WHEREAS,** DOT/PF will be compensating the borough for the market value of the land acquired; and
- **WHEREAS**, the KPB Planning Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting of July 9, 2001 recommended enactment by unanimous consent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly finds that selling the land described below to the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities at fair market value as identified below is in the public interest:
 - A. Homer High School, Assessor Parcel No. 177-020-55

A 0.06 acre parcel located within Tract 2, NEW HOMER HIGH SCHOOL NO. 2, according to Plat No. 87-11, Homer Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, and more particularly described as Parcel No. 1A on the attached DOT/PF plat, **Attachment A**. Sale price: \$3,925.00.

B. Homer Flex School, Assessor Parcel No. 177-035-06

A 0.0148 acre parcel located within the remainder portion of Lot 17, AA Mattox Subdivision 1958 Addition, Plat No. HM3746, Homer Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, and more

particularly described as Parcel No. 6 on the attached DOT/PF plat, Attachment B.

Sale price: \$725.00.

C. Paul Banks Elementary School, Assessor Parcel No. 179-030-18

> A 0.0974 acre parcel located within that portion of the E½SW¼ of Section 16, Township 6 South, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian, commonly known as the Paul Banks Elementary School, in the Homer Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, and more particularly described as Parcel No. 23 on the attached DOT/PF plat. Attachment C.

Sale price: \$636.45.

- **SECTION 2.** The mayor is authorized, pursuant to KPB 17.10.100(D) providing for cooperative sales, to negotiate the sale of the land described in Section 1 above with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) for the above-listed prices. The borough land shall be conveyed by quitclaim deed. The authorization is for negotiation solely with DOT/PF, and DOT/PF may not assign any rights to negotiate or enter an agreement for exchange to any other person or entity without the borough's written approval.
- **SECTION 3.** Conveyance of the borough land shall comply with the provisions of KPB 17.10.130(A), (B), (C) and 17.10.240 where applicable.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.



RIGHT-OF-WAY REQUIRED


