KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2001-27

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING FOR FIVE YEARS THE AUTHORITY TO EXERCISE TRANSPORTATION FUNDING POWERS

- WHEREAS, in Ordinance 2000-19-06, the assembly enacted KPB Chapter 13.10, Transportation, and adopted transportation funding powers; and
- WHEREAS, the adoption of KPB Chapter 13.10 and transportation funding powers will automatically expire on September 12, 2001, unless extended by ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, the Central Area Rural Transit System, Inc., a nonprofit corporation which is developing and implementing a public transportation plan, has received funding in the amount of \$50,000 pursuant to Ordinance 2000-19-06 and is budgeted to receive an additional \$50,000 for transportation services in Ordinance 2001-19; and
- WHEREAS, the assembly deems it in the best interest of the borough to continue for five more years the exercise of transportation funding powers; and
- WHEREAS, in Ordinance 2000-19-06, the assembly also provided that despite the automatic expiration on September 12, 2001, KPB 13.10 would continue in full force and effect until June 30, 2002, as to any grants or contracts awarded before September 12, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That KPB Chapter 13.10 is continued in full force and effect until September 30, 2006, on which date it will automatically expire unless extended by ordinance, provided that it shall continue in full force and effect until June 30, 2007 as to any grants or contracts awarded prior to September 30, 2006.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
