**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2001-41**

**AN ORDINANCE REDIRECTING \$550,871 IN GENERAL OBLIGATION SCHOOL
BOND PROCEEDS FROM THE KENAI CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL INSULATION
PROJECT TO THE SOLDOTNA HIGH SCHOOL FIRE ALARM PROJECT**

- WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly previously appropriated \$550,871 in general obligation school bond proceeds for the Kenai Central High School Insulation Project through the enactment of Ordinance 2000-19-17 on January 9, 2001; and
- WHEREAS,** Ordinance 2000-32 enacted by the assembly on August 15, 2000 and Proposition 1 passed by a majority of borough voters who voted in the October 3, 2000 general election provided for the approval of a specific list of school capital improvement projects as well as other educational capital improvement projects chosen by the borough and approved by the Department of Education and Early Development; and
- WHEREAS,** through the passage of Senate Bill 29, the Alaska State Legislature authorized a grant to fund the Kenai Central High School Insulation project, that was previously funded with general obligation school bond proceeds as approved by the borough assembly, borough voters and the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development; and
- WHEREAS,** the legislative grant resulted in duplicate funding for the Kenai Central High School Insulation project; and
- WHEREAS,** it is administratively most efficient to complete the Kenai Central High School Insulation project using legislative grant funds, delete it from the list of approved bond projects, and replace it with a substitute project chosen by the borough and approved by the Department of Education and Early Development; and
- WHEREAS,** the school district and the borough administration have concluded that the excess bond funds resulting from the project deletion should be used to fund the upgrade of the Soldotna High School fire alarm system; and
- WHEREAS,** The Alaska Department of Education and Early development has approved substitution of the Kenai Central High School Insulation project with a new project to upgrade the fire alarm system at Soldotna High School.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$550,871 in general obligation school bond funds previously appropriated through Ordinance 2000-19-17 for the Kenai Central High School Insulation project, account number 401.73020.00ISL.49999, are redirected to the Soldotna High School Fire Alarm project, account number 401.76020.00FAS.49999.


SECTION 2. That the appropriation established through this ordinance is of a project length nature and as such does not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
