KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2002-08

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING KPB 14.10.080 TO PROVIDE A REVIEW PROCESS FOR STREETS NAMED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION

- **WHEREAS**, the borough is in the process of naming or renaming a number of streets for 911 purposes and the convenience of the public; and
- WHEREAS, the public has valuable input regarding historical or local names for streets; and
- WHEREAS, there is no appeal to the board of adjustment for street names because streetnaming is not a quasi-judicial function of the planning commission; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to provide a review process by the assembly for streets named by the planning commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That KPB 14.10.080 is hereby enacted as follows:

14.10.080. Street name review.

Upon receipt of a \$300 review fee, a person who submitted a written statement or gave oral testimony at the public hearing before the planning commission regarding naming or renaming a street may request a review of the street name by the assembly. The request for review shall be on a form provided by the planning department and shall be filed within 15 days of signature on the planning commission resolution. The assembly shall apply the standards set forth in this chapter. A public hearing shall be held regarding the street name. Notice of the public hearing shall be given to persons who filed written or oral testimony with the planning commission. A name on a petition alone is not adequate to entitle a person to request a review or receive notice of the public hearing before the assembly. If a street name is changed by the assembly after public hearing, the planning commission shall adopt a resolution recognizing the new name.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect on January 2, 2002. Review of a street name change may be requested within 15 days after enactment of this ordinance if a street name resolution was adopted by the planning commission between January 2, 2002 and the enactment date of this ordinance.
