**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2002-19-12**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF STATE FUNDS FOR
EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT AND A RESCUE VEHICLE, AND
APPROPRIATING \$130,000 TO THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY
SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area (“Service Area”) identified the need for updating some of their emergency response equipment and for a new rescue vehicle, and included their requests for funding in the Borough’s 2002 legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 2006, which included funding for the Service Area’s projects, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development that two legislative grants have been awarded to the Service Area; one in the amount of \$30,000 for emergency response equipment, and the other in the amount of \$100,000 for a rescue vehicle; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on August 26, 2002, the Service Area Board of Directors recommended acceptance of the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept the above-described grant funds from the Department of Community and Economic Development on behalf of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area and is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.


SECTION 2. That grant funds are appropriated as follows:

\$30,000 to account 444.51410.03091.48514 for emergency response equipment,
and
\$100,000 to account 444.51410.03092.48310 for a rescue vehicle.


SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
