**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2002-19-17**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF STATE FUNDS FOR
DEVELOPING A TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND APPROPRIATING \$200,000 TO A
PROJECT ACCOUNT**

WHEREAS, a borough-wide transportation study has not been conducted since 1992; and

WHEREAS, the borough has areawide planning powers; and

WHEREAS, an up-to-date transportation study will provide data that can be used to develop an intermodal transportation plan as well as assist in decision-making for capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, a grant application was submitted to the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities ("DOT/PF") to provide an intermodal transportation plan for the Kenai Peninsula Borough for use in comprehensive planning; and

WHEREAS, the grant application was supported by the Assembly through enactment of KPB Resolution 2002-088; and

WHEREAS, notice has been received from DOT/PF that a grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$181,940 for transportation planning; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a local match of \$18,060; and

WHEREAS, funds previously appropriated for the Borough's comprehensive plan are available to meet the matching requirement of \$18,060;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept the above-described grant funds from the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$181,940 are appropriated to account 271.94910.03BUS.43011 for development of a comprehensive transportation plan.


SECTION 3. That matching funds in the amount of \$18,060 are transferred from account 100.2110.02COM.43011 to account 100.94910.00000.50271, interfund transfers.

SECTION 4. That \$18,060 in interfund transfers from the general fund shall be appropriated to account 271.94910.03BUS.43011.

SECTION 5. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
