**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2002-19-20**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$55,583 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE  
ANCHOR POINT SOLID WASTE TRANSFER SITE - ELECTRIC SERVICE  
INSTALLATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Department is in the process of completing improvements at the Anchor Point Solid Waste Transfer Site; and

**WHEREAS,** the Homer Electric Association final written cost estimate to provide electric service is \$55,583.00; and

**WHEREAS,** electric service is an essential element of the transfer site operations as it provides site lighting, which is critical for site safety and security; and

**WHEREAS,** current funding for the Anchor Point Solid Waste Transfer Site Construction project is not sufficient to cover these costs; and


**WHEREAS,** a shortened hearing is requested to provide funding as soon as possible in order to complete the work before winter weather causes a delay.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That \$55,583 is appropriated from the general fund to account number 411-32220-03TSM-43011 for installation of electric service by Homer Electric Association at the Anchor Point Solid Waste Transfer Site.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
