**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 2002-19-29**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM THE ALASKA  
DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF  
EMERGENCY SERVICES, TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF THE KENAI PENINSULA  
BOROUGH LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Kenai Peninsula Borough established the Local Emergency Planning Committee ("LEPC") to meet requirements of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act ("EPCRA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the LEPC membership consists of private individuals, public entities and industry representatives who serve as a public education and information source for disaster preparedness throughout the borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Services, has provided fiscal year 2003 baseline funding in the amount of \$25,000 to support core LEPC activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$25,000 may be used for support services, supplies, capital equipment purchases, and/or contractual services for the LEPC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough's Office of Emergency Management will administer the grant on behalf of the LEPC for the purposes stated above;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept the appropriation in the amount of \$25,000 from the Alaska Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Emergency Services.

**SECTION 2.** That the grant funds are appropriated to Account No. 263.91120.LEP03.49999.


**SECTION 3.** That the mayor is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.
