## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2002-19-32

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE U.S. NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$399,659 FOR THE COOK INLET SALMON BRANDING PROJECT

- WHEREAS, in July 2002 the borough submitted an application to the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) for funding under the Saltonstall-Kennedy Program; and
- WHEREAS, the borough has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$399,659 for the Cook Inlet salmon branding program; and
- WHEREAS, the grant program requires a minimum cost share of 10 percent of the total project cost; and
- WHEREAS, Cook Inlet Salmon Brand, Inc. (CISB), a nonprofit corporation established to implement the branding project received a State legislative grant in the amount of \$93,000; and
- WHEREAS, \$73,550 of the State grant to CISB was transferred to the borough and appropriated to the Cook Inlet salmon branding program through enactment of KPB Ordinance 2002-19-25; and
- WHEREAS, CISB has allocated \$40,000 of the state grant to meet the cost share requirement of the NOAA grant; and
- WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant from NOAA will allow the CISB to continue the Cook Inlet salmon branding project for another year; and
- WHEREAS, CISB will use the funds to train certified inspectors, market certified branded salmon, and other authorized purposes; and
- **WHEREAS,** the borough may exercise economic development powers on a non-areawide basis pursuant to AS 29.35.210; and
- **WHEREAS,** KPB 19.30.020-19.30.070 provides policies and procedures for newly proposed economic development projects, and this is an ongoing project previously supported by the assembly;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That notwithstanding the provisions of KPB 19.30.020-19.30.070, the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration in the amount of \$399,659 for the Cook Inlet salmon branding program and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant and fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance. The funds will be used on a non-areawide basis to train certified inspectors, to market the branded fish, and other activities as authorized in the grant documents.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$399,659 are appropriated to account 275.11225.BRAND.49999.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
