KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2002-19-36

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,000 FOR DEVELOPING COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAMS

- WHEREAS, in 2002 a new federal program was formed to encourage the development of Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT) within local communities; and
- WHEREAS, under the CERT program, local citizens are trained to be better prepared to respond to emergency situations in their communities and to provide critical support to first responders, provide immediate assistance to victims, and organize spontaneous volunteers at a disaster site; and
- **WHEREAS,** federal grant funding is available to assist in the implementation of a local CERT program; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough applied for funding under this program and has received notice from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security of a grant award in the amount of \$14,000; and
- **WHEREAS,** having a CERT program within the borough would provide a valuable volunteer resource capable of supporting and supplementing the borough's responses during and after a disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$14,000 for implementing a CERT program and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$14,000 are appropriated to account 271.91240.3CERT.49999.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
