**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2002-19-37**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,937 FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR UPDATING THE BOROUGH'S DISASTER EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

WHEREAS, federal funding is available to assist communities in developing and/or updating all hazards emergency operations plans; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Office of Emergency Management (OEM) applied for funding under the All Hazards Emergency Operations Planning Grant program administered by the Alaska Division of Homeland Security (ADHS); and

WHEREAS, OEM has received notice from ADHS of a grant award in the amount of \$27,937.00 for updating the Borough's Disaster Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Disaster Emergency Operations Plan was last updated in October 1997; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's plan should be updated to provide the most accurate and complete plan available; and

WHEREAS, an up-to-date disaster operations plan will provide operating procedures that include use of current technology that can assist in decision-making during emergency disasters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of \$27,937 from the Alaska Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security, and is authorized to execute all documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.

SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of \$27,937.00 are appropriated to account 271.91240.3DEOD.49999.


SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
