KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2003-19-10

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000 FOR RESEARCH AND MAPPING OF SECTION LINE EASEMENTS

- WHEREAS, research and identification of section line easements is a daily challenge for the Borough, surveyors, the public, title companies, realtors and review agencies due to incomplete information and inconsistencies; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") has funding available to conduct research and mapping projects under its Alaska Cadastral Project; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Department submitted an application to DNR for funding to hire a researcher and a mapping technician; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for section line easements research and mapping; and
- WHEREAS, information gathered during this project will be made available to the public through the Borough's Web site and on the public access terminal in the Borough Planning Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$70,000 for research and mapping of section line easements, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$70,000 are hereby appropriated to account 271.25000.04LIN.49999.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
