**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2003-19-10**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE
ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000
FOR RESEARCH AND MAPPING OF SECTION LINE EASEMENTS**

WHEREAS, research and identification of section line easements is a daily challenge for the Borough, surveyors, the public, title companies, realtors and review agencies due to incomplete information and inconsistencies; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") has funding available to conduct research and mapping projects under its Alaska Cadastral Project; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Department submitted an application to DNR for funding to hire a researcher and a mapping technician; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for section line easements research and mapping; and

WHEREAS, information gathered during this project will be made available to the public through the Borough's Web site and on the public access terminal in the Borough Planning Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Department of Natural Resources in the amount of \$70,000 for research and mapping of section line easements, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$70,000 are hereby appropriated to account 271.25000.04LIN.49999.


SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
