KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2003-19-11

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$68,200 FOR FOREST HEALTH RESTORATION

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is currently implementing a Forest Health Restoration Program to mitigate the effects of the spruce bark beetle infestation; and
- **WHEREAS,** the assembly in Ordinance 2003-21 extended the authorization for emergency harvest of spruce bark beetle killed timber identified as representing a forest fire hazard; and
- WHEREAS, the KPB is dedicated to reforesting all public land harvested for fuel reduction and through Ordinance 2000-19-19 appropriated \$1,050,000.00 towards reforesting spruce bark beetle infested land; and
- WHEREAS, the KPB is scheduled to plant approximately 2000 acres at a cost of \$272,800 during the summer of 2004 to rehabilitate Borough-owned land harvested because of the spruce bark beetle infestation; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service ("Forest Service") has funding available for the Borough's Forest Health Restoration Program on a cost-share basis of 25% Forest Service/75% KPB towards 2004 Borough planting costs; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Department submitted an application to the Forest Service for \$68,200 to supplement its costs of the Forest Health Restoration Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$68,200; and
- WHEREAS, the grant program requires a local match in the amount of 75% of the project cost, or \$204,600; and
- WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$204,600 are currently available for this purpose in the approved Planning Department Spruce Bark Beetle budget in account 262.21320.01BT3.43011; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough to accept and appropriate the Forest Service grant money to benefit the ongoing Borough Forest Health Restoration Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service, in the amount of \$68,200 for the Borough Forest Health Restoration program and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept the grant.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$68,200 are hereby appropriated to account 262.21320.04FOR.43011.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriation established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
