**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2003-19-31**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$596,836.53 FROM THE DIVISION OF
EMERGENCY SERVICES TO REIMBURSE THE BOROUGH FOR COSTS
INCURRED IN RESPONDING TO FLOODING OCCURRING FROM OCTOBER 23,
2002 TO NOVEMBER 12, 2002**

WHEREAS, the borough was hit by a number of fall storms between the dates of October 23, 2002 and November 12, 2002 causing flooding; and

WHEREAS, the road service area provided emergency access for borough citizens and incurred costs totaling \$454,924.34 associated with road and bridge washouts; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance department repaired damage at Homer area schools caused by flooding and mud slides totaling \$141,912.19; and

WHEREAS, a disaster was declared by the Borough Mayor on October 25, 2002, by Governor Knowles on November 6, 2002, and by President Bush on December 4, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the costs incurred by the borough are eligible for reimbursement from FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) through the State of Alaska, Division of Emergency Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That \$596,836.53 in costs incurred by borough departments and service areas in response to these storms be appropriated to the Disaster Relief Fund, 260.11262.3FLDX.49999.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
