**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2003-19-48**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$121,453 FROM THE
ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION TO PURCHASE
DECONTAMINATION SYSTEMS AND TRAILERS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough applied for funding from the FY 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program ("SHSGP") for three hazardous materials decontamination systems and associated equipment to be used in the event of exposure to hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Environmental Conservation ("DEC") had developed a statewide hazardous materials decontamination strategy, which contemplated providing one decontamination shower and trailer to the Kenai Peninsula Borough to be located in the Central Peninsula area; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2003 SHSGP grant to the borough was only sufficient to fund one unit and part of the equipment needed to make the unit fully operational; and

WHEREAS, the city of Seward also received funding from the FY 2003 SHSGP grant which was only enough to purchase components of a decontamination system and not to provide an operational system; and

WHEREAS, following subsequent discussion between borough personnel, the DEC, and the State Haz-Mat Response Advisory Board, the DEC has agreed to provide additional funding for one more trailer and associated equipment for both the central peninsula system and the Seward system to purchase a fully operational system including necessary equipment to be located in Homer; and

WHEREAS, these funds will enable the borough to completely outfit three decontamination trailers with lighting systems, heated decontamination shelters, and personal protective equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of \$121,453 from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for the purchase of two additional decontamination systems and trailers, and decontamination equipment for these two systems and trailers and the third unit previously funded,

and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 2. That the grant funds in the amount of \$121,453 are appropriated to account No. 271.11250.4HMLS.48515.

SECTION 3. That the mayor is authorized to use the results of the state procurement process to purchase the equipment.


SECTION 4. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
