**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2003-19-51**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$7,100 FROM THE ALASKA
DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR
THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough established the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) to meet requirements of the "Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act"; and

WHEREAS, the LEPC membership consists of private individuals, public entities, and industry representatives who serve as a public education and information source for disaster preparedness throughout the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management ("ADHS"), provided fiscal year 2004 baseline funding in the amount of \$17,900 to support core LEPC activities, such as personnel, supplies, capital equipment, and/or contractual services; and

WHEREAS, ADHS has additional funding available for the 2003/2004 fiscal year and can provide supplemental funding to the Borough LEPC in the amount of \$7,100 for eligible expenses that have been incurred by June 30, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's LEPC has costs that would be eligible for reimbursement under the LEPC's proposal; and

WHEREAS, the grant is available only during the 2003/2004 fiscal year and must be appropriated prior to the expiration date;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$7,100 for LEPC operations and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of \$7,100 are appropriated to account 263.91120.LEP04.49999.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
