AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$1,395 FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough established the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) to meet requirements of the "Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act"; and
- WHEREAS, the LEPC membership consists of private individuals, public entities and industry representatives who serve as public education and information sources for disaster preparedness throughout the borough; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management ("ADHS&EM"), provided fiscal year 2004 baseline funding in the amount of \$17,900 to support core LEPC activities, such as personnel, supplies, capital equipment, and/or contractual services; and
- WHEREAS, ADHS&EM has additional supplemental funding available in the amount of \$1,395 for the purchase of a digital projector, if the purchase is made prior to June 30, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough's Office of Emergency Management has funding available in its FY03/04 budget and can purchase the projector prior to June 30, which purchase would be eligible for reimbursement under the LEPC's proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$1,395 for the purchase of a digital projector and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$1,395 are appropriated to account 263.91120.LEP04.48710.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
