KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH **ORDINANCE 2004-19-12**

APPROPRIATING \$37,500 IN SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE SOLID WASTE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM, TYONEK LANDFILL - BURN BOX PURCHASE, TRANSPORTATION & INSTALLATION

- WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department is in the process of making improvements at the Tyonek Landfill; and
- WHEREAS, the revised cost estimate to purchase, transport and install a burn box is estimated at \$77,500.00 of which \$40,000 was previously appropriated as part of the FY2005 Budget Ordinance 2004-19; and
- WHEREAS, the burn box is an important element of the landfill operations providing a waste management technique that saves landfill airspace, deters wildlife attraction, and reduces windblown litter which are critical for site safety and long term site development; and
- WHEREAS, the current funding for the Solid Waste Capital Improvements Program Tyonek Landfill is not sufficient to cover these costs; and
- WHEREAS, the general fund balance has sufficient funds available for this work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI **PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

- SECTION 1. That \$37,500 is appropriated from the general fund balance to the inter-fund transfer account number 100.94910.00000.50411.
- **SECTION 2.** That appropriated in Fund 411. \$37,500 is account number 411.32180.05TYK.43011 as additional funding for the cost to purchase, transport and install a burn box in Tyonek.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
