**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2004-19-18**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A STATE GRANT IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FOR DISTANCE LEARNING EQUIPMENT FOR THE SOUTH
KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area (“Service Area”) identified the need for interactive satellite distance learning capability and included a request for funding in the Borough’s 2004 legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 283, which appropriated funding to the Borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor in July 2004; and

WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$10,000 for distance learning equipment for the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on October 7, 2004, the Service Area Board of Directors recommended enactment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$10,000 for the purchase and installation of distance learning equipment for the Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of \$10,000 are appropriated to account 491.81211.05061.48210.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
