## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2004-19-31

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A DUAL HEAD NUCLEAR GAMMA CAMERA FOR THE CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL AT A NOT-TO-EXCEED COST OF \$339,257 WITH FUNDING TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE CPGH, INC. PLANT REPLACEMENT AND EXPANSION FUND

- WHEREAS, The Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. (CPGH, Inc.) current camera has only one head and does not provide adequate configurability to accommodate many patient needs, which results in many patients being sent elsewhere for tests; and
- WHEREAS, the replacement of the current camera with a Dual Head Nuclear Gamma Camera will enhance quality health care that meets the patients' needs; and
- WHEREAS, the best available price for the Dual Heal Nuclear Gamma Camera is through Philips Medical Systems, N.A. in the amount of \$323,102, including accessories and training; and
- WHEREAS, CPGH, Inc. has included a 5 percent contingency, in the amount of \$16,155, for building modifications to accommodate the equipment, if required; and
- WHEREAS, the CPGH Service Area Board approved the purchase of this Dual Head Nuclear Gamma Camera at its November 8, 2004 meeting;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1**. The Assembly approves the purchase of the Dual Head Nuclear Gamma Camera for CPGH, Inc.
- **SECTION 2.** The sum of \$339,257 is appropriated from the CPGH, Inc. Plant Replacement and Expansion fund to Account No. 490.81111.05CH3.49999 for the Dual Head Nuclear Gamma Camera project.
- SECTION 3. The mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into a contract with Philips Medical Systems N.A. for the purchase of a new Dual Head Nuclear Gamma Camera for CPGH for a cost not to exceed \$323,102, including accessories and training.

**SECTION 4**. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
