## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2004-19-36

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A \$110,200 GRANT FROM THE DENALI COMMISSION AND APPROPRIATING THE GRANT AND ADDITIONAL FUNDS OF \$41,800 TO THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT FOR BURNBOXES IN NANWALEK AND SELDOVIA

- WHEREAS, the Borough currently has an integrated solid waste program which includes five rural landfills; and
- WHEREAS, the purchase of burnbox units for rural communities will have a positive impact on waste management by minimizing waste required for burials, maximizing landfill airspace, and reducing windblown litter; and
- WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department would like to purchase and install burnboxes in the communities of Nanwalek and Seldovia at an estimated cost of \$152,000; and
- WHEREAS, the Denali Commission has a grant program that provides funding for solid waste activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough applied for funding under this program and has received notice of award of a grant in the amount of \$110,200 to provide burnboxes in Nanwalek and Seldovia; and
- WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$41,800 is needed to complete the acquisition, and for transportation and installation; and
- WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has previously solicited bids for a burnbox at Tyonek and received only one bid from Summit Consulting Services; and
- WHEREAS, Summit Consulting Services, Inc. ("Summit") has submitted quotes of \$47,850 and \$67,500, respectively, for a burnbox for each of the communities of Nanwalek and Seldovia; and
- WHEREAS, Summit's bid is fair and reasonable and they are qualified to perform the work;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Denali Commission in the amount of \$110,200 for burnboxes in Nanwalek and Seldovia, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$55,100 are appropriated to account 411.32160.05NAN.
- SECTION 3. That grant funds in the amount of \$55,100 are appropriated to account 411.32140.05SEL.
- **SECTION 4.** That \$41,800 is appropriated from the Solid Waste fund balance to the interfund transfer account number 290.32010.50411.
- SECTION 5. That \$22,400 is appropriated from the interfund transfer account to Fund 411, account number 411.32160.05NAN, as additional funding to purchase, transport, and install a burnbox in Nanwalek.
- SECTION 6. That \$19,400 is appropriated from the interfund transfer account to Fund 411, account number 411.32140.05SEL, as additional funding to purchase, transport, and install a burnbox in Seldovia.
- **SECTION 7.** That the mayor is authorized to enter into a sole-source contract with Summit Consulting Services, Inc., for the purchase of two burnboxes, such contract not to exceed \$115,350.
- **SECTION 8.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- SECTION 9. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
