**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2004-19-39**

**AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$53,871.48 TO THE ROAD SERVICE AREA
HENRY CREEK BRIDGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FROM
COMPLETED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND AWARDING THE
HENRY CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT TO COVEY ENTERPRISES**

WHEREAS, the Henry Creek Bridge Capital Improvement Project (“CIP”) is an approved fiscal year 2004 road service area (“RSA”) CIP project; and

WHEREAS, the project was advertised in the Peninsula Clarion on November 16 and 29, 2004, the Homer News on November 18, 2004, and the Seward Phoenix Log on November 18, 2004; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on January 13, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the low responsive bid was \$93,526.48 submitted by Covey Enterprises; and

WHEREAS, engineering fees for this project are estimated to be \$9,270.00; and

WHEREAS, the project budget currently contains \$48,925.00; and

WHEREAS, there is a shortfall of \$53,871.48 needed to award this project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in completed RSA CIP projects to cover the engineering fees and to award this project to Covey Enterprises;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to transfer \$53,871.48 to the Henry Creek Bridge CIP project from completed RSA CIP projects as follows:

<u>Project</u>	<u>Amount to be transferred</u>
Project 04C04, Leisure Lake Drive/Lonely Street	\$8,114.60
Project 04C06, Terrace Drive	\$45,756.88


SECTION 2. That these funds shall be transferred to account 434.33950.04S06.43011, the Henry Creek Bridge project.

SECTION 3. That upon the transfer of these funds the mayor is authorized to award a contract to the low bidder, Covey Enterprises for the Henry Creek Bridge CIP project in the amount of \$93,526.48.

SECTION 4. That the mayor is authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
