## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2004-19-50

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,271.00 FOR THE BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA FOR FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY

- WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area ("BCFSA") would like to expand its fire safety education program by establishing an annual Bear Creek Fire Prevention Fair; and
- WHEREAS, during the Fire Prevention Fair, smoke detector/carbon monoxide ("CO") alarms will be distributed to community residents, along with fire safety information, and a Fire Safety Rodeo will be held for children ages 1-18 to learn about fire safety; and
- WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Prevention Fair officers a great opportunity for educating the community about fire safety and prevention; and
- WHEREAS, State Statutes require that all dwellings be outfitted with a CO detector by January 2005; and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security ("USDHS") has an Assistance to Firefighters Grant program to help rural fire departments with funding for fire prevention and safety; and
- WHEREAS, BCFSA applied for funding to purchase supplies needed for the Fire Prevention Fair, specifically smoke detectors/CO alarms and educational materials; and
- WHEREAS, BCFSA has received notice of a grant award in the amount of \$8,271.00 for the purchase of supplies for the Fire Prevention Fair; and
- WHEREAS, the grant program requires that (1) grantees share in the cost of the project, (2) grantees serving jurisdictions of 50,000 or fewer residents provide a non-federal cost share of 10 percent of the total project cost, and (3) the cost share must be in cash; and
- WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$919.00 are currently available in the approved FY05 BCFSA budget in account 207.51210.5HLS3.42222 (fire prevention supplies); and

- WHEREAS, the local share contribution of \$919.00 and the USDHS grant amount of \$8,271.00 will provide a total of \$9,190.00, which is the total approved project cost, to be used for purchasing fire prevention supplies; and
- WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting held April 12, 2005, the BCFSA Board recommended enactment by unanimous consent; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$8,271.00 for purchasing supplies for a fire prevention and safety program for the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$8,271.00 are hereby appropriated to the Bear Creek Fire Service Area account 207.51210.5HLS3.42222 (fire prevention supplies).
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
