**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2004-21**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A VOTE ON THE QUESTION OF ADOPTING A
MANAGER PLAN OF GOVERNMENT AT THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION**

WHEREAS, Alaska Statutes provide that the borough may adopt a manager plan of government, which is initiated either by petition or by motion adopted by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, a manager plan of government changes the administration of the borough from the current form in which the elected mayor is the chief administrator for the borough to a manager form of government in which a manager appointed by the assembly is the chief administrator; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.20.470 requires the governing body to provide by ordinance or resolution for a vote on the question of adopting a manager plan at the next election when it adopts a motion to submit the question to the voters; and

WHEREAS, the requisite motion is included in this ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the assembly hereby approves a motion to adopt a manager plan of government as provided in Alaska Statute 29.20.460(a).

SECTION 2. That a ballot proposition shall be placed on the ballot in the next regular borough election, to be held October 5, 2004, which shall read as follows:

Shall the borough change its administration from the current elected mayor form to a manager form, where the manager is appointed by the borough assembly?

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
