**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2007-19-06**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A STATE GRANT IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FOR PURCHASE OF ATV RESCUE / FIRE SUPPORT
EQUIPMENT FOR THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area (“Service Area”) has identified the need for ATV rescue / fire support equipment for fire response in a 200-square-mile area, much of which is backcountry recreation area; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly included a request for funding for this project in the Borough’s 2007 State Funding Priorities; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 53, which appropriated funding to the Borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor in June 2007; and

WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$15,000 for ATV rescue / fire support equipment for the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on July 12, 2007, the Service Area Board of Directors recommended that the grant be accepted and appropriated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$15,000 for the purchase of ATV rescue / fire support equipment for the Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of \$15,000 are appropriated as follows:

\$14,557 to account 446.51810.08300.49999 – Project Account
\$ 443 to account 446.51810.08300.61990 - Administrative service fee

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
