## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH **ORDINANCE 2007-19-08**

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A STATE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR PURCHASE OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT FOR THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area ("Service Area") has identified the need for emergency response equipment to enhance the Service Area's capabilities in responding to emergencies, especially those that occur in remote areas; and
- WHEREAS, the Assembly included a request for funding for this project in the Borough's 2007 State Funding Priorities; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 53, which appropriated funding to the Borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor in June 2007; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$50,000 for emergency response equipment for the Service Area; and
- WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on July 11, 2007, the Service Area Board of Directors recommended that the grant be accepted and appropriated; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$50,000 for the purchase of emergency response equipment for the Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$50,000 are appropriated as follows:

\$48,525.00 to account 441.51111.08306.49999 - Project Account \$ 1,475.00 to account 441.51111.08306.61990 - Administrative service fee

**SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

**SECTION 4**. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
