## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA RESOLUTION 2007-11

## A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING SPECIFIC PROJECTS FOR THE 2008 LEGISLATIVE GRANT FUNDS

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has received Fiscal Year 2008 legislative grants totaling \$1,075,000 to pave or upgrade certain roads in the service area; and
- WHEREAS, there has been pubic interest in how the Road Service Area intends to spend these funds; and
- WHEREAS, it is anticipated the amount of funds identified for each road project may not be enough to provide a completed pavement project; and
- WHEREAS, the RSA Board has agreed to contract with an engineering consultant to review preliminary engineered estimates on each road project to determine the feasibility of completing a paving project on these roads; and
- WHEREAS, the engineer estimates will determine if these projects will require supplemental funding using the non-designated legislative grant (\$250,000) and RSA Capital Improvement Project funds if necessary; and
- WHEREAS, should this review determine it is economically feasible to upgrade and pave these individual roads, and supplemental funds are approved, the roads will be paved; and
- WHEREAS, should the review determine the cost to upgrade and pave would be exorbitant the road will only be upgraded as funds allow.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA BOARD:

- **SECTION 1.** The legislative grant of \$250,000 for Community College Drive, in Soldotna, shall be spent to pave the section of road completed through our 2005 CIP project.
- **SECTION 2.** The legislative grant of \$300,000 for Bastein Drive, in Nikiski, shall be spent as determined through a preliminary engineering analysis of the cost to upgrade and/or pave this road.
- **SECTION 3.** The legislative grant of \$275,000 for Midway Drive, in Sterling, shall be spent as determined through a preliminary engineering analysis of the cost to upgrade and/or pave this road.

**SECTION 4.** The legislative grant of \$250,000 for Borough-Wide Road Improvements will be utilized as needed.

**SECTION 5.** A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the mayor and the assembly.
