KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2007-19-21

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$106,000 OF INTEREST INCOME TO FUND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH FUNNY RIVER STATION LIVING OUARTERS

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2005-28 (Mayor Substitute), Central Emergency Service Area voters authorized the issuance of general obligation debt of \$2,500,000 to pay the cost of planning, designing, construction, equipping, and financing a fire station in Kasilof and renovating the fire station in the Funny River area; and
- WHEREAS, bond proceeds totaling \$2,500,000 were appropriated through Ordinance 2005-19-54; and
- WHEREAS, due to higher than projected costs to complete construction of the Kasilof fire station, which is now complete, there are insufficient funds available to complete the construction of the Funny River Station living quarters; and
- WHEREAS, interest income of approximately \$106,000 has been earned on this project and is available to support the expenditures associated with this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That \$106,000 in interest income is appropriated to account 401.51611.06CES.49999 (New Kasilof/Funny River Renovation Project) to support expenditures associated with the completion of the living quarters at the Funny River fire station.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
