**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2007-19-28**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE
ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY
MANAGEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,750 FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE
EQUIPMENT FOR KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management offers funding to emergency service providers through the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Office of Emergency Management submitted a Borough-wide application, which included requests from the Cities of Homer, Kenai and Seward, and from two service areas, Bear Creek Fire Service Area and Kachemak Emergency Service Area, for SHSP funding; and

WHEREAS, the State has provided the Borough with a notice of award of \$25,750 for five ALMR-compatible mobile radios for Kachemak Emergency Service Area; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough to provide its emergency responders with interoperable equipment that is compatible with the State's ALMR system; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting held November 8, 2007, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area Board recommended enactment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$25,750 and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 2. That funds in the amount of \$25,750 are appropriated to KESA accounts as follows:

\$25,000.00 to account 446.51810.34054.49999 – Project Account
\$ 750.00 to account 446.51810.34054.61990 - Administration

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.

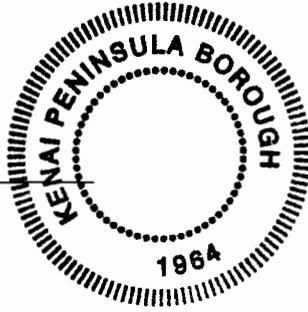
