Since the introduction of the Proposed FY2009 budget at April 15, 2008 assembly meeting, the assessing department has provided updated assessed values to the finance department. The updated values are an increase of approximately \$375,000,000 over what was previously provided. It should be noted that not all areas are seeing an increase, including the Nikiski area, the Seward area, and the K-beach area.

The following is a summary of changes in assessed values for the impacted funds.
