## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2008-19-03

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A STATE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$550,000 FOR THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA FOR PURCHASE OF A FIKE ENGINE

- WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area ("Service Area") conducted a department vehicle assessment and determined the need for two Type A fire engines to replace two of its 24-year-old apparatus; and
- WHEREAS, the Assembly included a request for funding for this project in the Borough's 2008 State Funding Priorities; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 221, which appropriated funding to the Borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor in May 2008; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$550,000 for the Service Area for a Type A fire engine; and
- WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on June 11, 2008, the Service Area Board of Directors recommended acceptance of this grant;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$550,000 for the purchase of a Type A fire engine for the Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$550,000 are appropriated to the following Service Area account: 441.51111.09483.48514 Nikiski Fire Service Capital Projects Fire Fighting Equipment account.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
