**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2008-19-07**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A STATE GRANT IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$505,000 FOR SCHOOL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES**

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District has identified a need to provide funding to schools throughout the borough for various materials, equipment and supplies; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 221, which appropriated funding to the Borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor in May 2008; and

WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the Borough in the amount of \$505,000 for equipment and supplies for various schools throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the School District will use these funds for classroom equipment and various program needs; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of these grants will benefit many of the schools and students throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, as the School District will pay all required expenditures and will be responsible for all administrative action related to these grants, with the exception of filing the grant reports, the administrative fee established by KPB Resolution 2006-036 will be waived;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$505,000 for school district equipment and supplies, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$505,000 are appropriated to account 271.94910.09220.49999, a contingency account.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
