## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA RESOLUTION 2008-06

## A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING ACCEPTANCE OF A STATE LEGISLATIVE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,400,000 FOR BOROUGH-WIDE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 221, which appropriated \$8.4 million to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for borough-wide road improvement projects, was passed by the state legislature and signed by the governor in May 2008; and

WHEREAS, these are five-year grant funds and will expire June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, these funds may be appropriated to roads designated by Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, a portion of these funds are to be allocated to the Keystone Drive Project that the RSA Board approved via RSA Resolution 2008-04.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA BOARD:

**SECTION 1.** That the Road Service Area Board recommends the Mayor accept the grant from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$8,400,000 for KPB road improvements.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
